 6. Understanding water meters to improve efficiency

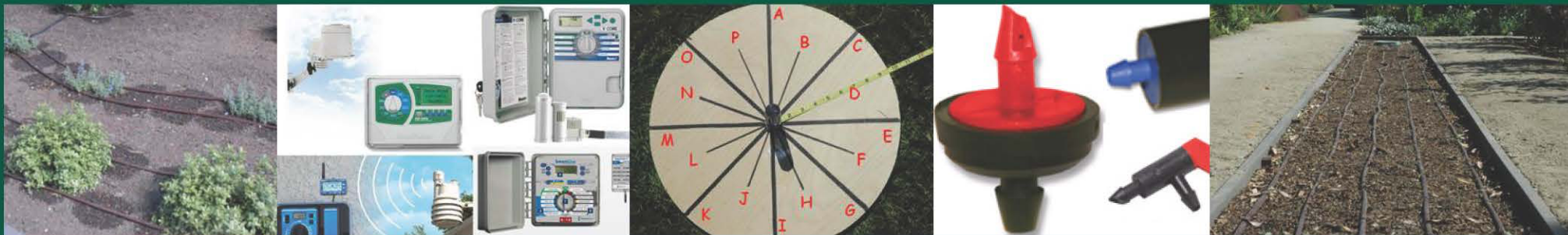
